Specific requirements in terms of call scope	This funding opportunity is jointly supported by the Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR) and the National Natural Science Foundation of China (NSFC). Each application must be a collaborative project involving researchers in each country. Proposals must focus on the mental health of one or more populations in China but may also include populations in another LMIC and/or indigenous populations in Canada.

Co-investigator requirements	<p>Research teams must be comprised of at least one Canadian and one Chinese independent researcher. A Principal Applicant in each country (Canada and China) is required. The team must also include at least one decision-maker and/or policy-maker.</p> <p>If teams include a focus on LMICs in addition to China, the team must include a Principal Applicant from each additional LMIC.</p> <p>For teams working with Canadian indigenous populations, there must be at least one team member listed as Principal Applicant, co-applicant, Principal Knowledge User or Knowledge User from a Canadian indigenous community.</p>

Anticipated amount of funding available for this call	<p>Up to 7 grants will be funded joint by CIHR and NSFC.</p> <p>For Canadian researchers, the total per grant is up to \$215,000 CAD per year for up to 5 years.</p> <p>For Chinese researchers, the total per grant is up to 1 million RMB per year for up to 5 years.</p>
