

Photo and video consent at GACD events: Conditions of use

Photography and filming take place at GACD in-person events, such as the Annual Scientific Meeting and implementation science training events. It is likely that images and videos containing your likeness ('identifying personal data') will be used for GACD communications. Your image may be viewed and accessed globally ('international data transfer').

Therefore, we seek consent from attendees to use their likeness in our communications and promotional activities (social media, website, print, and other reasonable materials).

By providing consent, you agree to:

- GACD using your images in photography and/or video recordings taken/recorded during the event on the GACD website, in GACD social media, and in other reasonable GACD communications materials.
- Photographs and/or video recordings being used by GACD-associated third parties (on request) on their websites or for other reasonable communications purposes. Third parties include GACD Associate Members, GACD-funded project teams, or by external companies, commissioned or employed by GACD, for the production or publication of materials, on behalf of GACD.

GACD will ensure that:

- Your images are stored in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018.
- Your images are used for the purposes outlined above.
- You can withdraw your consent at any time by emailing admin@gacd.org.

If the image has already been used in printed publications, GACD will not be able to recall all copies in which it has appeared. However, GACD will delete the image from our database and will go to all reasonable efforts to stop using the image in the future.
